



**Master of Science Program in Dentistry
(International Program)
Major in Advanced General Dentistry**

1. Entry requirements:

- 1.1 Must be a graduate with a DDS Degree from an accredited dental school. International students having no a DDS degree are required to provide class rank and academic curriculum of their programme at the home institution.
- 1.2 Must have cumulative GPA of at least 2.50
- 1.3 Must have at least one year working experience in dental practice.
- 1.4 Other English language requirements: (validity of two years)
 - a) TOEFL iBT score of at least 54 or
 - b) TOEFL ITP score of at least 480 or
 - c) IELTS score of at least 5.0 or
 - d) MU Grad TEST score of at least 60
- 1.5 Must have dental license from the Thai Dental Council or any other license that the Program committee considers equivalent
- 1.6 Must fulfill the regulations of the Faculty of Graduate Studies as appeared on the website: www.grad.mahidol.ac.th/grad/admission. An exemption from compliance with the regulations may be granted by the Programme Committee and Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

- Pre-treatment photographs	7 views
- Post-treatment photographs	7 views
- Pre-treatment and post-treatment radiographs following the guideline for prescribing dental radiograph 1988 and AAPD 1993	
- The patient needs at least 2 treatments in each quadrant and each quadrant should have filling or crown in/on at least	1 tooth
10.2 Other complete case(s)	
- The remaining complete cases may be either recall case or referral case	
- No photograph is required	
10.3 Pediatric complete cases (5 cases) should include at least	
- Pulp treatment (primary molar)	1 tooth
- Stainless steel crown	1 tooth
- Special treatment (medically compromised patient or space maintainer)	1 case

Graduates should be able to work in the government or private hospital or dental clinics.

5. Uniqueness of the course:

Graduates should be able to provide comprehensive dental treatment planning and give more advanced dental treatment in some areas compared to the undergraduate students.
