



**Graduate Diploma Program in Clinical Science
In Maxillofacial Prosthetics
(International Program)**

1. Entry requirements:

- 1.1 Must be a graduate with a DDS Degree from an accredited dental school. International students having no a DDS degree are required to provide class rank and academic curriculum of their programme at the home institution.
- 1.2 Must have cumulative GPA of at least 2.50
- 1.3 Must have at least one year working experience in dental practice.
- 1.4 Other English language requirements: (validity of two years)
 - a) TOEFL IBT score of at least 54 or
 - b) TOEFL ITP score of at least 480 or
 - c) IELTS score of at least 5.0 or
 - d) MU Grad TEST score of at least 60
- 1.5 Must have dental license from the Thai Dental Council or any other license that the Program committee considers equivalent
- 1.6 Must fulfill the regulations of the Faculty of Graduate Studies as appeared on the website: www.grad.mahidol.ac.th/grad/admission. An exemption from compliance with the regulations may be granted by the Programme Committee and Dean of the Faculty of Graduate Studies.

2. Course fees (in Baht)

3. Skill development on the course:

The course aims to produce specialists in Maxillofacial Prosthodontics that are well rounded and with an internationally acceptable standard. Skill developments on the course include:

- To increase and expand knowledge in diagnosis, analysis, treatment planning in order to treat patients with modern technology in the field of basic for advanced maxillofacial prosthodontics. Graduate are required enroll for the master degree.

- To learn the clinic skills including rehabilitation of acquired oral and facial defects, congenital defects e.g. cleft palate, and implant prosthetics.

- To master the clinical and research skill related to maxillofacial prosthodontics.

- To assist and cooperate the treatment with other medical specialists.

- To provide the consultation to medical and dental personnel from other fields in order to render the optimal care to patients.

- To understand the parameters of the field and capable of referring patients to other field of specialty.

- To have the capability of transferring, exchanging and distributing knowledge.

4. Potential areas of employment for graduates:

A maxillofacial prosthodontics as part of a multidisciplinary maxillofacial team in hospitals and universities.

5. Uniqueness of the course:

Maxillofacial prosthodontics program at Mahidol University is unique because of its hands-on interaction with patients, dedicated staff and excellent rapport with a multidisciplinary team of other medical and surgical specialties. In addition to the opportunities to learn the clinical and laboratory skills, the program offers a comprehensive didactic program and innovation research prospects.
